The DBE program requires that you contact our office if any significant changes occur in your firm. This includes changes in any of the following: business address, the types work the firm performs, locations that the firm performs work and ownership or control of the firm.

Your firm must also comply with DBE eligibility requirements, which include that the DBE owner(s) must continue to demonstrate majority ownership, control of the firm's day-to-day operations, and direct and ongoing involvement in the firm's management. You must also continue to demonstrate direct involvement in contracts or projects on which the DBE Program applies and your participation is counting toward the goal.

Additionally, on an annual basis you are required to file an "Affidavit of DBE Eligibility" (No Change Affidavit) with supporting documentation. The No Change Affidavit form requests information about the firm's size, gross receipts, ownership, and work areas. The form requires that you attest to your firm's continued adherence to the DBE program eligibility requirements. It is deemed a failure to cooperate pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Part 26.109(c) if this Affidavit is not submitted in a timely manner or inaccurate information is provided which is a

- Maintain an accurate mailing address with MnUCP.
- Maintain a working phone number.
- Promptly return all solicitation inquiries.
